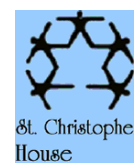

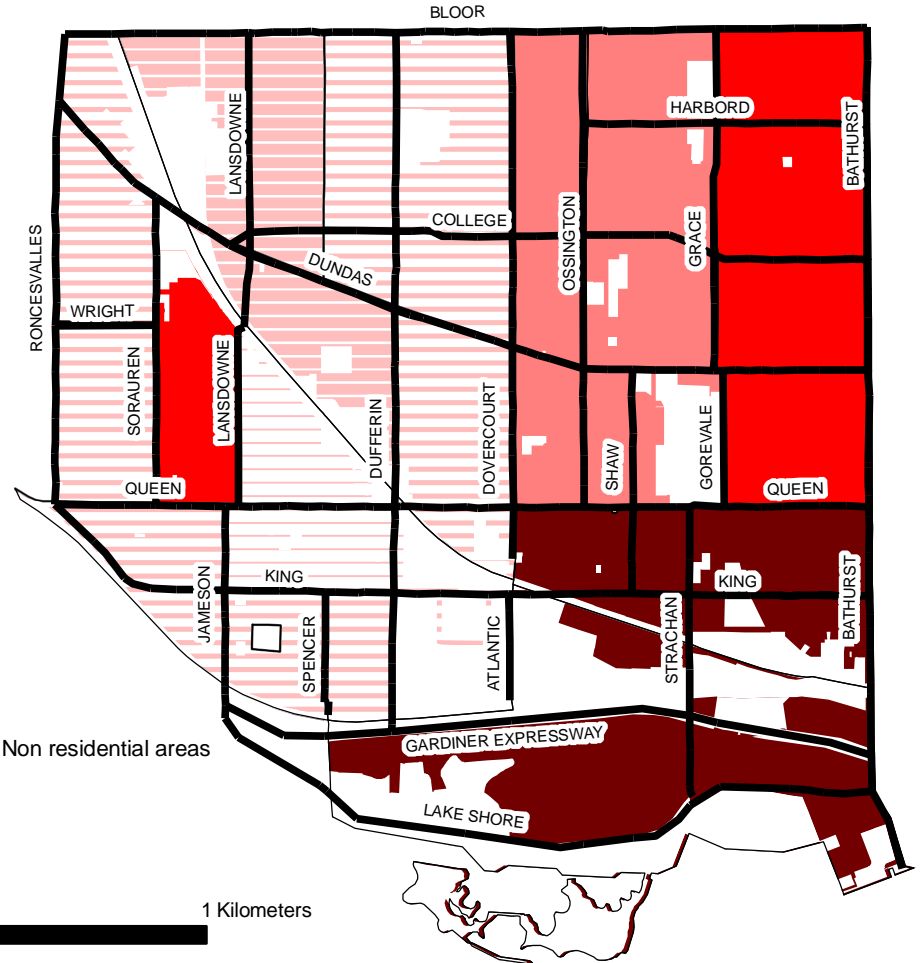
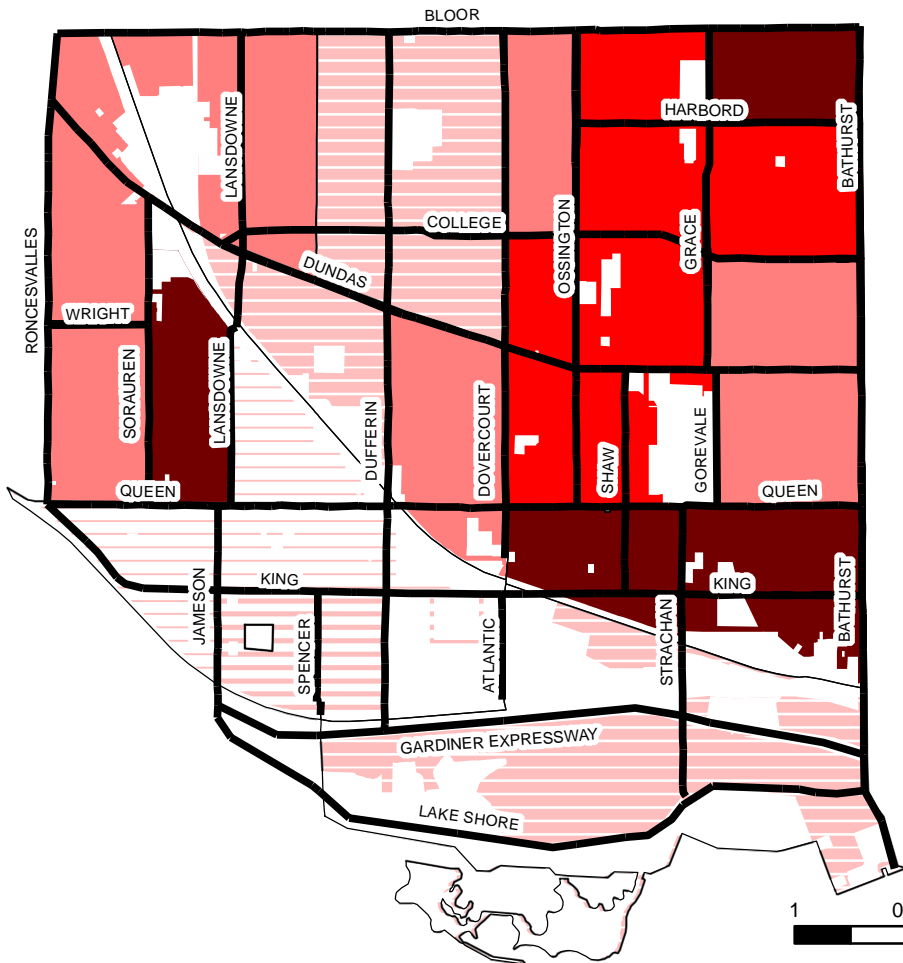

MEDIAN HOUSEHOLD INCOME IN THE CURA STUDY AREA

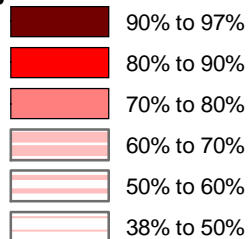

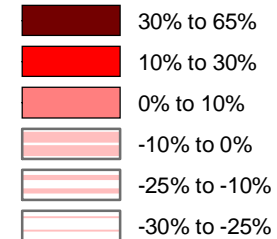

Percentage Change in Median Household Income compared to Toronto CMA Median 1971 to 2001



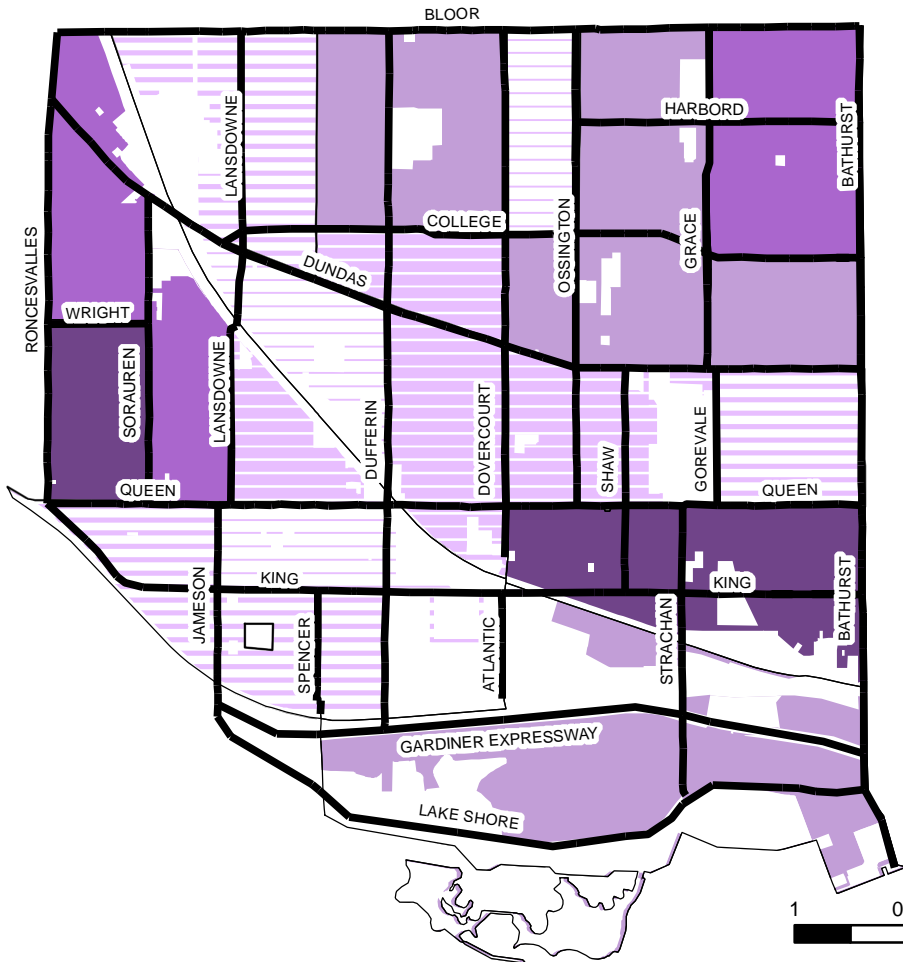

# MAP 8 PERSONS EMPLOYED IN MANAGEMENT OCCUPATIONS IN THE CURA STUDY AREA

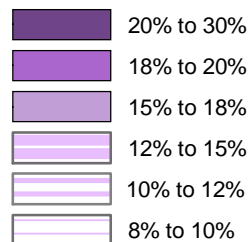

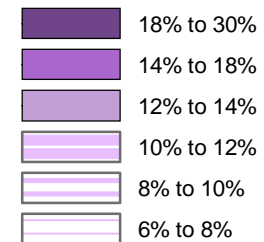
